- a. All Entries must be original artworks made by 4 - 12 year old's
- b. All artwork needs to be dropped off at Darlington Tennis Club for judging on
Monday October 10th from 4:30pm – 7pm OR
Tuesday October 11th from 4:30pm – 7pm
- c. No artwork will be accepted after these dates.
- d. Maximum of one entry per child.
- e. The age groupings for prizes are 4-6-, 7-8-, 9-10- and 11–12-year-olds.
- f. Due to limited space, we DO NOT allow artworks larger than A1 size.

3. Insurance and Liability

Artwork may be damaged due to the foot traffic over the weekend.
We have volunteers looking after your work and DO NOT let the public touch your art.
We will not take art that is a danger to the public. 3D work needs to be stable and not sharp or hazardous.
The artist must acknowledge and accept that the Darlington Arts Festival, its committee, officials and volunteers accept no liability for loss of, damage to or theft of the work submitted.
